

Elsema Remote Programming Guide

Programming Elsema PentaFOB® Remotes and Receivers

There are two ways to pair PentaFOB® remotes:

- 1. Programming from Remote to Receiver
- 2. Programming from Remote to Remote

Remote to Receiver:

- 1. Ensure all switches on the receiver's 12-way DIP switch are set to "OFF".
- 2. Hold down the program button on the receiver.
- 3. Press and hold a button on the remote for 2 seconds until the receiver LED blinks and turns green.
- 4. Release both the receiver and remote buttons.
- 5. Test by pressing the remote button to activate the receiver.

Remote to Remote (ensure you're near the receiver):

- 1. Open a working remote and briefly press the program button on the back of its board to enter learning mode.
- 2. Press the same button on the working remote to activate the receiver.
- 3. Press and hold a button on the new remote for 2 seconds.
- 4. Press the program button again on the working remote to exit learning mode.
- 5. Test the new remote to confirm it works with the receiver.

Erasing All Remotes from Receiver Memory:

Short the Code Reset pins on the receiver for 10 seconds to clear all stored remotes.

Using the PentaFOB® Programmer:

This tool helps add or delete specific remotes from memory, ideal for lost remotes or former tenants.

PentaFOB® Backup Chips:

Backup chips let you save or restore receiver memory, useful when many remotes are programmed and a backup is required in case of damage.
